- Use the Ecological Framework to understand GBV in individual settings and develop multi-level programme interventions

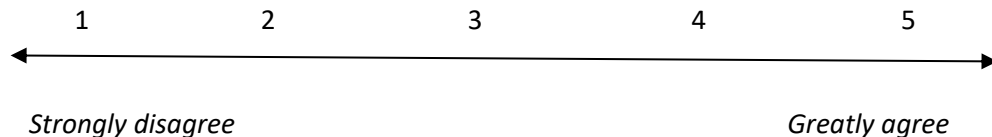
Specifically, participants will be able to:

3. Implement and coordinate good quality multi-sectoral programme activities.

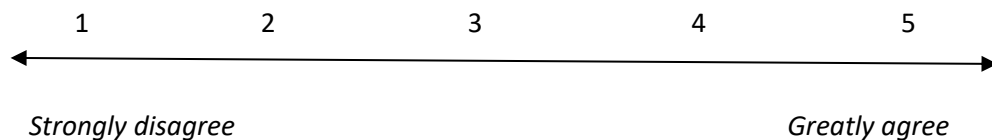

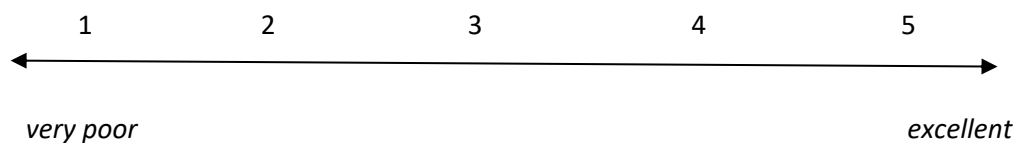


